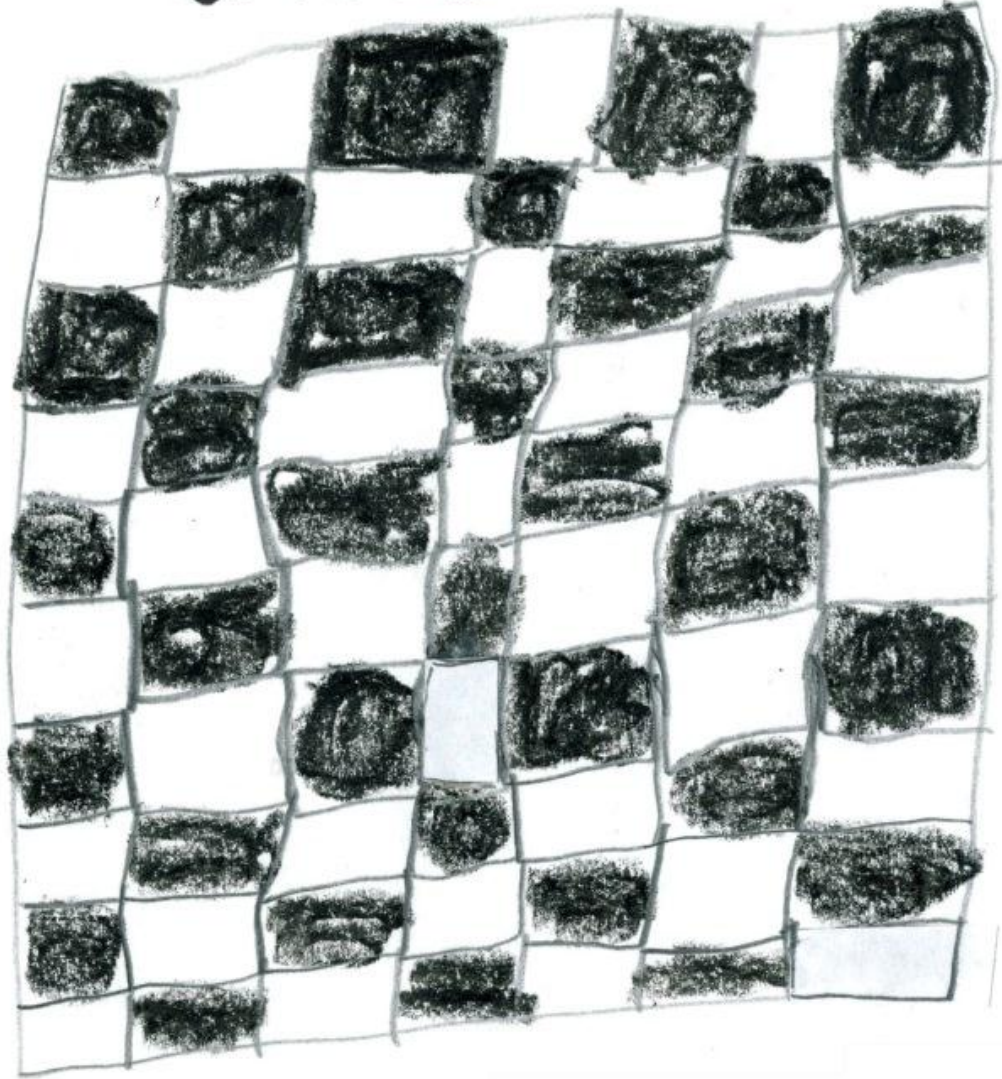


# Chess

I like to play chess. Would you like to learn how? Here's how it goes. A rook is worth five points. It can move up, down and sideways.





A pawn is worth one point. A pawn has a choice of moving two spaces or just one on its first move.

A knight is worth three points. A knight can move like a 7 or an L . It moves three spaces.



A bishop can move seven spaces or less. It is worth three points. It can move diagonally.



A queen is worth nine points. It's like all the pieces combined. It's the most powerful piece on the board!





A king is worth the whole game. There are two things that a king can get into. One is called a check. You have to move your king or block the check.



The second one is the checkmate. You can't move out of a checkmate, so then you lose the game!
