


How Legos Came Into The World




Once upon a time there was war between the eastern countries and the southern countries. No city was free from war.

"Silence and fight soldier!" ordered the Southern Grand General.




The southern army set up traps and forgot to warn the townspeople and ended up trapping innocent people.

The Southern army kept fighting and fighting, but it was useless!




The Southern army set up rope around the city, but the posts broke and since the rope was stretched out so much it broke buildings!

"I don't believe this will work," yelled the general.


Alex gave him a bunch of Legos. Three hours later the general was still playing around building a model of the castle.
